- The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) on December 30,
 2019 approved extension in the deputation tenure of Director of Special
 Protection Group (SPG), IPS Arun Kumar Sinha for a period from March
 19, 2020, to July 30, 2021.
- Jammu & Kashmir union territory administration announced public holiday on October 26 (Accession Day).
- Army Chief Gen Bipin Rawat was on December 30, 2019 appointed India's first Chief of Defence Staff with a mandate to bring in convergence in functioning of the Army, the Navy and the Indian Air Force and bolster the country's military prowess.
- Sanjay Gupta, the editor-in-chief of 'Jagran', has been selected for the 'Lokmanya Tilak National Journalism Award' by the Pune-based Kesari-Maratha Trust
- Nagaland Assembly Speaker Vikho-o Yhoshu died in Mumbai on

- Hardeep Singh Puri, Minister of State (I/C) for Civil Aviation, launched
 the Biometric enabled Centralised Access Control System (CACS) and 'eBCAS (e-Bureau of Civil Aviation Security) Project Training Module' in
 New Delhi on December 30, 2019. The objective behind launching these
 two projects is to enhance security and ease of doing business at
 airports.
- Phase-1 services of the e-Governance (eGCA) project of Directorate
 General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) was launched by the Ministry of Civil
 Aviation in New Delhi on December 30, 2019. This has automated the
 issuance of Commercial Pilot License (CPL-A), Flight Radio Telephony
 Operators License (FRTOL) and Instrument Rating.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on December 30, 2019 released a draft circular on limits on exposure to single and group borrowers and revision in priority sector lending targets for urban cooperative banks (UCBs).
 Prudential exposure limits for UCBs for a single borrower and a group of connected borrowers will be 10% and 25% respectively of their tier-one capital.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on December 30, 2019 released a draft circular on priority sector lending targets of UCBs. The target for loans and advances to the priority sector for UCBs will be increased to 75% of adjusted net bank credit or credit equivalent amount of off-balance sheet exposure, whichever is higher, by March 31, 2023
- Products made by women self-help groups formed under the DAY-NULM (Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission) will now be available on e-commerce platforms as the government on December 30, 2019 signed an MoU with Flipkart in this regard.



- The last date for the mandatory linking of the Permanent Account
 Number (PAN) with Aadhaar has been extended till March 31, 2020, the
 CBDT said on December 30, 2019.
- Fred P. Graham, US journalist who covered the Supreme Court and momentous legal affairs of his era for The New York Times, CBS News and Court TV, died in Washington at the age of 88 on December 29, 2019.
- India skipper Virat Kohli and fast bowler Jasprit Bumrah are the only two Indians who found a place in Wisden's T20 International team of the decade. Australia's Aaron Finch was named captain of the team.
