- Vijay Mallya let his island mansion fall into disrepair, a bank has alleged. The mansion has now been listed for sale.
- Lewis Hamilton is out of contract at the end of the 2020 season and has had talks with Ferrari, although the champion looks more likely to stay with Mercedes now that the Italian team have committed long-term to Monegasque youngster Charles Leclerc.
- The UN's World Economic Situation and Prospects report revealed that the growth estimate for the current fiscal is drastically lower than the forecast of 7.6 per cent made in last year's report in January and 7 per cent in the May update.
- Shah Rukh Khan on Thursday was spotted giving Bollywood lessons to Amazon CEO Jeff Bezos. The actor taught the CEO his popular dialogue from his film Don.
