(n.)

Drive carefully to avoid an **accident**.
 To avoid *sudden damage and injury* we must drive carefully. ▶



ache

(n.)

I have a stomach **ache**.
 I have got *pain* in my stomach.

acorn

(n.)

An **acorn** is the seed of an oak tree.

across

(prep.)

He swims **across** the river.
 He swims *to the other side* of the river.

act

(v.)

I **act** in the play 'The Merchant of Venice'.
 I *perform* in the play.

active

(adj.)

He is a very **active** boy in the class.
 He is a very *energetic* boy.

add

(v.)

Add one more pencil in the box.
Put in one more pencil to increase the number.

address

(n.)

Write down the **address** on the envelope.
 Write down the *particulars of where you live*, to deliver the mail.

adequate

(adj.)

Put **adequate** salt in the dish.
 Add *sufficient quantity* of the salt to taste.

admire

(v.)

Great leaders are **admired** by the people.
 Great leaders are *highly respected* by the people.

admission

(n.)

Admission of outsiders is prohibited.
Entry of outsiders is not allowed.

admit
 (v.) He **admits** his mistake.
 He *accepts* his mistake.

adult
 (adj.) **Adults** have the right to vote. All the *grown ups* have a right to choose their representative.

advance
 (n.) *Money paid to someone before a particular time*
 She asked for some **advance**.
 Pay your monthly fees **in advance**. (*idiom*)

adventure
 (n.) *an unusual, exciting and dangerous activity*
 River rafting is a great **adventure** ▶
 for us.



advice
 (n.) His **advice** helps me a lot.
 His *suggestion* is of great help to me.

aeroplane
 (n.) An **aeroplane** is a machine that flies through the air.

afraid
 (adj.) He is **afraid** of ghosts.
 He is *frightened* of ghosts.

after (1)
 (prep.) Summer comes **after** the winter season.

after (2)
 (conj.) I came **after** you did.
 I came *later than* you.

again
 (adv.) You have made the same mistake **again**.
Repeatedly you make the same mistake.

against
 (adj.) He is **against** my idea.
 He is *opposed to* my idea.

age
 (n.) What's your **age**?
How old are you?

ago
 (adv.) Long **ago** early men lived in caves.
In the past early men lived in caves.

agree
 (v.) My father has **agreed** to send me to the picnic.
 My father has *given me his consent* to go to the picnic.

ahead
 (adv.) Go **ahead** to reach your destination.
 Go *further* to reach your place.

aim
 (n.) Work hard to achieve your **aim**.
 Set a *target* and work hard to achieve it.



air
 (n.) We need **air** to survive.
 We need *an invisible gas in the atmosphere* to survive.

airport
 (n.) I went to the **airport** to receive my brother.
 I saw *the place where planes land and take off*.

alarm
 (n.) We have installed a fire **alarm** in our house.
 We have a fire *warning device* in our house.



album
 (n.) *a book for holding photographs*
 I saw the **album** which contains my childhood photographs.

algorithm
 (n.) An **algorithm** is a set of instructions, that is used to perform a certain task.

alive

(*adj.*)

Plants need sunlight to remain **alive**.

Plants need sunlight for *living*.

all

(*pron.*)

We **all** play together.

Everyone should play together.

alligator

(*n.*)

a large reptile with a hard skin

An **alligator** lives both in water and on land.

allow

(*v.*)

Don't **allow** him to go outside at night.

Don't *give him permission* of going outside at night.

almost

(*adv.*)

He has **almost** finished his work.

He has *very nearly* finished his work.

alone

(*adj.*),

(*adv.*)

He is **alone**. (*adj.*)

Don't cross the road **alone**. (*adv.*)

Don't cross the road *without others being present*.

along

(*prep.*)

The boy is walking **along** the road.

The boy is walking *from one end* of the road to *the other*.

already

(*adv.*)

I am **already** late.

I am late *before the time in question*.

also

(*adv.*)

He is **also** coming.

He is coming *likewise*.

always

(*adv.*)

Always come on time.

Whatever the circumstances, come on time *everytime*.

among

(*prep.*)

He always stays **among** his friends.

Ravi is always *surrounded by* his friends.
